CLASS TITLE: ATHLETIC FACILITIES MAINTENANCE WORKER
AUTHORIZED POSITION: CLASSIFIED
ASSIGNMENT LOCATION: YUBA COLLEGE

BASIC FUNCTION: Under the direction of the Director of Maintenance & Operations, prepare gymnasium, athletic fields, multi-purpose sports complex, grounds, and campus parking lots for scheduled events and classes; perform various minor maintenance and repair actions as required.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

Set-up, take-down, and perform minor maintenance and repair to equipment for physical education classes and athletic events; set up and operate score boards and public announcement system; make minor repairs as necessary. (E)

Operate lawn mower, edger, weeder, sweeper, rototiller, tractor, loader and other grounds equipment and tools. (E)

Maintain safety cleanliness, and playability of gymnasium, athletic fields, multi-purpose sports complex, grounds, and parking lots. (E)

Apply pesticides and herbicides according to established procedures. (E)

Measure, layout, and line athletic fields; renovate and maintain athletic fields; core, drag, grade, and overseed fields as needed. (E)

Maintain equipment as necessary; lubricate, sharpen blades. (E)

Assist in the installation and repair of concrete walks, patios, and mowing strips. (E)

Provide training and work direction to student assistants as assigned.

Perform related duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE OF:

Proper use and maintenance of grounds maintenance tools and power equipment
Proper care and maintenance of synthetic and natural turf, shrubs, trees, and lawns
Chemicals and fertilizers used in grounds maintenance
Athletic field dimensions
Set up and operation of physical education equipment
Health and safety rules and regulations

ABILITY TO:

Set up, adjust, operate, and make minor repairs to grounds maintenance and physical education equipment and tools

Maintain gymnasium, athletic fields, multi-sports complex, and campus parking lots in clean and safe condition

Apply grounds maintenance chemicals safely and effectively according to established procedures

Measure and line athletic fields

Make simple arithmetic computations

Meet schedules and time lines

Understand and follow oral and written instructions

Work cooperatively with others

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: Any combination equivalent to: graduation from high school and two years experience in repair and maintenance of physical education grounds and facilities.

Qualified Pesticide Applicator's Certificate within six months of employment

WORKING CONDITIONS:**ENVIRONMENT:**

Indoor and outdoor work environment

Seasonal heat and cold or adverse weather conditions

Pollen, dust, and fumes

Subject to evenings and weekend work hours

PHYSICAL ABILITIES:

Lifting, pushing, and pulling heavy objects

Dexterity of hands and fingers to operate athletic and grounds maintenance equipment

Seeing to read athletic field marking blueprints and to perform grounds work

Walking over rough or uneven surfaces

Climbing ladders and working from heights

Walking and standing for extended periods of time

Bending at the waist

HAZARDS:

Working around and with machinery having moving parts.

Fertilizer and pest control chemicals and related fumes.

Cleaning chemicals and related fumes.
